2. Every black person understands the truth of oppression
3. Mt. 12:30, Lk. 11:23- Jesus said, "He who is not with me is against me."

5. Produces a constant covert alertness
6. It is impossible to be passively neutral in oppression
7. The biggest factor for many blacks in America is weariness
8. Ps. 9:9- a place of refuge (Safety and openness, different value system, a place of reorientation)
9. Any person in oppression can thrive if they have a place of refuge
10. Every black person over fifty years old in this country have suffered much worse than PJ did and most black people younger also suffer much worse
