- 1. The Bible Goal of racial reconciliation is deep friendships and requires deep, mutual respect and mutual goals
- 2. Friendship isn't something that just happens
- 3. Just mutual respect is not enough for deep friendship
- 4. One of the two common pillars of friendship is common goals (Jam. 4: 4, Rom. 15:5, Amos 3:3, Jn. 15:4, Phil. 2:2)
- 5. 7 common goals: work, church, neighborhood, hobbies & sports, my children's activities, courses and church leadership
- 6. It generally takes two common purposes to build a close friendship
- 7. Most important point of the whole series: There are two groups: Group one is humble, white Christians who are opposed to racism because it's a moral evil. Group two is humble, white Christians who have personally experienced racism hurting their friend.
- 8. At Liberty Church, no more than fifty percent of the leadership will be white
